Assessing Membership Dues

as adopted by the 2003 General Meeting
in effect as of January 1st, 2004

The minimum membership fee (base fee) per member club is €256.00 Euro Dollars.

Clubs which have more than 75% hunter members pay €2.30 Euro Dollars
per member.

Clubs with less than 75% hunter members pay €2.30 Euro Dollars
per hunter.

For the non-hunter members among them, the above clubs pay a lump sum of
€500.00 Euro Dollars
for every 2000 members.

These clubs report their members separated by hunters and non-hunters. The applicable
percentage will be calculated every 4 years.

Hunting District Groups and Hunting Associations pay
for the first 1000 members €307.00 Euro Dollars
for the first 2000 members €409.00 Euro Dollars
for more than 2000 members €511.00 Euro Dollars

plus €2.50 Euro Dollars for each tested dog but not less than €25.00 Euro Dollars for each
test conducted. (The tests as listed in the most recently published Studbook [*DGStB*] will be
used as the basis for calculation).

Dues payable by State Hunting Associations (LJV) and
associated clubs are independently worked out,
but not to be less than €256.00 Euro Dollars
